Who can receive a berry donation from Driscoll's?

We donate berries to registered public charities like community clinics, volunteer fire departments, libraries, and other organizations that are qualified to receive tax deductible donations. These organizations use their berries for events like charitable fundraisers and public community gatherings.

When can I request berries?

Berries are available when they are in season and producing in your area – check our seasonal availability chart below! Your berry order may be updated based on weather conditions and current berry availability.

How far in advance do I need to request berries for my event?

You must submit your request **2 weeks prior** to your event. We use this time to coordinate your donation with our distribution center, ensuring that we'll have your berries in stock for you to pick up.

How many berries can I receive?

Your organization can receive up to **10 flats** of conventional berries each year. 1 flat of strawberries contains **8** 16oz. clamshells, and 1 flat of bushberries (blackberries, blueberries, and raspberries) contains **12** 6oz. clamshells.

How many berries do I need?

How many berries you will use depends on your event and what you're using the berries for – check out our **Recipes page** for ideas! Each clamshell of strawberries weighs 16 oz. and each clamshell of bushberries weighs 6 oz.

How do I pick up my berries?

Berry donations need to be picked up from the local distribution center that you selected when you placed your order. Once your donation has been approved, you will receive a confirmation email **within 10 days** of your event containing detailed location information and pickup instructions.
